

Minutes of the 6th Monitoring Committee Meeting held by Secretary(Environment Department) on 22/07/2023 in the matter of National Green Tribunal in OA No. 395/2013 Restoration of Periyar River

Meeting commenced at 4.30 PM with Secretary to Government, Environment Department presiding. The MD KWA, Director of Panchayat, Dy.Director LSGD, Commissioner, Land Revenue Commissionerate, District Collector Idukki, Ernakulam, Thrissur, Member Secretary, Kerala State Pollution Control Board, Chief Engineer Irrigation Department and officers of Environmental department, local bodies ,KWA, Irrigation Department, Suchitwa Mission, Amruth, KSITM, Industries Dept., were also present in the meeting.

Member Secretary, KSPCB briefed the order of Hon'ble NGT in OA 395/2013 on 27.05.2022 and regarding 6th monitoring committee. Then presentation was made regarding the action points formulated as per OA 395/2013- Restoration of Periyar River and reviewed the progress of the projects. Copy of PPT attached as annexure.
